Hospital-level care at home (ages 16–24)

Youth Hospital in the Home (Y-HiTH)

For young people aged 16 to 24 experiencing an acute mental health episode who would otherwise require hospital admission.

- Hospital-standard mental health care
- Delivered **in the home**, where appropriate
- Can support admission avoidance or step-down from hospital
- Access is via emergency or health services.
